read: john 15:9-17

unpack the text:

- (v. 9) "In my love" Indicates that they follow Jesus, who showed His love for them by being willing to sacrifice His life for them.
- (v. 14) "My friends" The way that Jesus' disciples reciprocate the friendship He showed them is by doing what He asked of them.
- (v. 16) "I chose you" Jesus means His disciples, whom He selected, and their calling as ministers. This is not a salvific.

ask questions:

Read John 15:9

- 1. What does it mean to abide in Christ's love?
- 2. How do we actively and practically abide and rest in the love of Christ?

Read John 15:10

3. What is the biggest way Christ fulfilled God's commandment for Him? What does that mean for us?

Read John 15:11 & Psalm 16:11

4. What is the source of joy for us? How can we have joy?

In verse 14 & 15 Jesus calls His disciples His friends.

- 5. Do You see Jesus as your friend? Why or why not?
- 6. What does it practically look like to love people? How do we do that?
- 7. Are there people in your life who love you well? How do they do that for you?

Read John 15:16 and Ephesians 2:4-5

8. If you were chosen by Jesus to be a child of God, and to be in relationship with Him, how should that affect you? What does that mean about your identity?
