

## DISCUSSION GUIDE

RECAP: Have your students summarize the message as best they can. Was there a quote that stuck out to them? Was there a Bible verse they'd never heard before?

Try to fill in the blanks yourself.

READ: Read John 17:24 out loud:
"Father, I want those you have given
me to be with me where I am, and
to see my glory, the glory you have
given me because you loved me
before the creation of the world."

REFLECT: Have your group stop and think for a moment about what God sacrificed for us by sending His Son to die. Then ask your group: How should that change the way we live our day to day lives?

REMEMBER: This phrase sums up the sermon well. Try to memorize it: "If you want to know how much God hates sin, look at the cross. If you want to know how much God loves you, look at the cross."

REQUEST: Ask 2 or 3 people in your group to pray out loud to close your time together. Finish by praying that we would remember how much God hates sin, and but also how much God loves us.
