



FAQ's about CAMP:

Q: How many chaperones will there be?

A: We require a strict 1-5 ratio of adult leaders to students. Students cannot go anywhere at camp without an adult.

Q: Are there extra costs associated with camp?

A: All of the activities are included in the cost of camp. Students are encouraged to bring \$20 for lunch on the way to camp and on the way back.

Q: Are all activities mandatory?

A: Yes and no! We'll strongly encourage everyone to participate, but if a student insists, they will not be forced to play. All services, meals, and small groups are 100% mandatory.

FAQ's about COVID-19:

Q: If the quarantine continues into June, is there a backup plan?

A: We have already secured a backup week of camp, and it is July 13-17.

Q: Will I be refunded in the event camp is canceled?

A: Yes. Full refunds will be made.

Q: Will I be refunded in the event camp is moved to July, but I'm unable to attend?

A: Yes. Full refunds will be made.

Q: What is the COVID-19 situation in the area surrounding our camp?

A: (On 4/13) Polk County, TN has only 5 cases. (Compare to 167 in Alachua County).

Q: Will there be any testing for students to ensure that no one has COVID-19?

A: Yes, all students will be asked to have their temperature taken before check-in.
