

READ: From Hebrews chapter 11, read verses 1 and 6 out loud. Most of us are quick to say we believe that God exists (v. 6), but do we actually believe He rewards us for seeking Him? Discuss before moving on.

RECAP: Ask 2 or 3 people from your group to try summarizing a part of message in their own words. Then ask someone else "anything they left out?" Be sure to wrap up by filling in any major parts the group missed.

REFLECT: What would you say are some things that keep you from walking in faith every day? It might be fear, it might be unbelief, or it might be worrying about what others will think. Try to list at least 3.

REMEMBER: There are TWO memory verses to pick from! The first is Hebrews 11:6, and the second is James 2:18. Have everyone in your group pick a verse to memorize, then choose a method for accountability.

REQUEST: Ask 2 volunteers to pray for the group, and then you can close the prayer out. Specifically pray that we would be people who live out our faith every day, preaching and proclaiming the gospel.
